By signing this form, you agree to accept and comply with the conditions stated below.

- An Organizer/Promoter who wishes to run a Breaking Ireland/DFI Competition must send a
 fully completed Competition Application form, to the Competition Committee, no later
 than 90 days prior to the proposed date.
- An Organizer/Promoter must provide a full list of competitions. No competition/s can be added on the day of the Tournament.
- The application will not be considered, should the application fee not be included with the application.
- The application fee will be returned to the applicant, should permission not be granted by the Competition Committee to organize the competition.
- The applicant has the right to appeal the decision of the Competition Committee within 30 days. An Appeals Committee will be set-up, consisting of 5 committee members to hear the appeal. The decision of the Appeals Committee will be final.
- The Breaking Ireland Project Leader can instruct the organizer to cancel an adjudicator.
- There must be a minimum of 3 adjudicators engaged for any competition.
- The proposed date of the competition must be a minimum of 28 days before and after another recognised Breaking Ireland/DFI competition.
- All applicants must be members of the DFI.
- Only recognized organizers can use the DFI logo, WDSF logo.
- Judges accommodation and flights or other commitments should not be completed until application is fully confirmed.
- Registration is managed by breaking Ireland utilising and8 system.
- The organizer agrees to use threefold judging system and competition flow defined by Breaking Ireland and and8. This includes facilitation of the technical requirements e.g., projector, Wi-Fi access. Breaking Ireland will help to finalise all details and support setting up.
- Event line-up should not include any other 1vs1 breaking battles.
- Line-up can't be published and promoted without Breaking Ireland review and approval. Appropriate time needs to be allocated for Breaking Ireland ranking battles.
- Organiser is required to run the following Breaking Ireland sections:
 - o B-boys under 16
 - o B-girls under 16
 - o B-boys over 16
 - o B-girls over 16
